8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 53-6-115, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"53-6-115. Contracts with other agencies alternative payment methods. (1) The department
12	of public health and human services may by suitable rules provide for contracting with any state or private agency
13	for processing and payment of claims under the program of medical assistance, and the department may contract
14	with one or more private or state agencies to provide any or all of the enumerated medical services.
15	(2) In order to provide for cost savings and increase access to prescription drugs, the department shall
16	whenever possible use a subscription model as an alternative payment method for high-cost or specialty drugs
17	that treat a specific disease or medical condition. A contract awarded under a subscription model must:
18	(a) require the contractor to deliver an unrestricted supply of the prescription drug for a specified period
19	of years;
20	(b) cap the annual payment for the drug at the amount spent by the medicaid program on the drug in the
21	fiscal year preceding the year in which the contract is awarded; and
22	(c) include the use of supplemental rebate agreements to meet the contract price."

24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$5,000 from the general fund to the
25	department of administration for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, to pay for the costs of preparing requests
26	for proposals and awarding contracts for obtaining prescription drugs for the medicaid program using the
27	subscription model provided for in 53-6-115.

29	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2019.
