1	WHEREAS, the 66th Legislature of the State of Montana honors David Thatcher for his exemplary life
2	of service.

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
5	
6	NEW SECTION. Section 1. David Thatcher memorial highway. (1) There is established the David
7	Thatcher memorial highway on existing state highway 419 from state highway 419's intersection with state
8	highway 78 to state highway 419's intersection with state highway 420 JUNCTION WITH STILLWATER ROAD.
9	(2) The department shall design and install appropriate signs marking the location of the David Thatcher
10	memorial highway.
11	(3) Maps that identify roadways in Montana must be updated to include the location of the David
12	Thatcher memorial highway when the department updates and publishes the state maps.
13	
14	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
15	integral part of Title 60, chapter 1, part 2, and the provisions of Title 60, chapter 1, part 2, apply to [section 1].
16	
17	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
