| 11 | "7-33-4107. Qualifications of firefighters. The state of Montana determines that qualifications for the         |
| 12 | firefighting profession must recognize the rigorous physical demands placed on firefighters and the expectation |
| 13 | of many years of emergency service. To qualify as a firefighter, an applicant:                                  |
| 14 | (1) must be a citizen or lawful permanent resident of the United States;                                        |
| 15 | (2) must be at least 18 years of age;                                                                           |
| 16 | (3) must be a high school graduate or have been issued a high school equivalency diploma by the                 |
| 17 | superintendent of public instruction or by an appropriate issuing agency of another state or of the federal     |
| 18 | government;                                                                                                     |
| 19 | (4) must possess or be eligible for a valid Montana driver's license;                                           |
| 20 | (5) shall pass a physical examination by a qualified physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice       |
| 21 | registered nurse, who is not the applicant's personal physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice      |
| 22 | registered nurse, appointed by the employing authority to determine if the applicant is free from any mental or |
| 23 | physical condition that might adversely affect the applicant's performance of the duties of a firefighter;      |
| 24 | (6) must be fingerprinted and a search must be made of the local, state, and national fingerprint files to      |
| 25 | disclose any criminal record; and                                                                               |
| 26 | (7) may not have been convicted of a crime for which the applicant could have been imprisoned in a              |
