4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT GENERALLY REVISING QUALIFICATIONS RELATED TO
5	CITIZENSHIP; REVISING FIREFIGHTER QUALIFICATIONS; ALLOWING A LAWFUL PERMANENT RESIDENT
6	TO BE EMPLOYED AS A FIREFIGHTER; AND AMENDING SECTION 7-33-4107, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
7	IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
10	
11	Section 1. Section 7-33-4107, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"7-33-4107. Qualifications of firefighters. The state of Montana determines that qualifications for the
13	firefighting profession must recognize the rigorous physical demands placed on firefighters and the expectation
14	of many years of emergency service. To qualify as a firefighter, an applicant:
15	(1) must be a citizen <u>or lawful permanent resident</u> of the United States;
16	(2) must be at least 18 years of age;
17	(3) must be a high school graduate or have been issued a high school equivalency diploma by the
18	superintendent of public instruction or by an appropriate issuing agency of another state or of the federal
19	government;
20	(4) must possess or be eligible for a valid Montana driver's license;
21	(5) shall pass a physical examination by a qualified physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice
22	registered nurse, who is not the applicant's personal physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice
23	registered nurse, appointed by the employing authority to determine if the applicant is free from any mental or
24	physical condition that might adversely affect the applicant's performance of the duties of a firefighter;
25	(6) must be fingerprinted and a search must be made of the local, state, and national fingerprint files to
26	disclose any criminal record; and
27	(7) may not have been convicted of a crime for which the applicant could have been imprisoned in a
28	federal or state penitentiary."
