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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Cost tracking and recovery. (1) The IF THE commission shall approve
11	APPROVES a cost-tracking adjustment for a public utility regulated in accordance with chapter 8 or under this
12	chapter-
13	(2) Cost-tracking adjustments for a public utility, THE COST-TRACKING ADJUSTMENT must provide for:
14	(a) identical treatment of public utilities subject to chapter 8 or this chapter;
15	(b) 90% shareholder CUSTOMER and 10% customer SHAREHOLDER sharing of costs, if cost sharing is
16	required; and
17	(c) full recovery of costs incurred by a public utility as a result of qualifying small power production facility
18	purchase requirements established in Title 69, chapter 3, part 6.
19	(3)(2) A cost-tracking adjustment may not include a deadband.
20	(4)(3) For the purposes of this section, "deadband" means a level of cost recovery variance, including
21	levels of under-recoveries and over-recoveries to be borne by the public utility.
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23	Section 2. Section 69-8-210, MCA, is amended to read:
24	"69-8-210. Public utilities cost tracking environmentally preferred resources. (1) The
25	commission may shall approve a cost-tracking adjustment for a public utility regulated under this part consistent
26	with its regulation of public utilities under Title 69, chapter 3.
27	(2) Notwithstanding any service options that the commission may require, a public utility shall offer its
28	customers the option of purchasing a product composed of or supporting power from certified environmentally
29	preferred resources that include but are not limited to wind, solar, geothermal, and biomass, subject to review
30	and approval by the commission. The commission shall ensure that these resources have been certified as

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1	meeting industry-accepted standards."
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3	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
4	integral part of Title 69, chapter 3, and the provisions of Title 69, chapter 3, apply to [section 1].
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6	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
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
