| 14 | property consistent with, but not more stringent than, applicable legal obligations, giving consideration to |
| 15 | reasonably anticipated future uses of affected property. |
| 16 | (2) When contracting for the performance of construction, alteration, demolition, installation, repair, or |
| 17 | maintenance work to implement a remediation plan, an owner shall require that its contractors and any |
| 18 | subcontractors use a skilled and trained workforce to perform all remediation. Contracts signed must require |
| 19 | contractors and subcontractors to: |
| 20 | (a) pay the standard prevailing rate of wages as defined in 18-2-401 for remediation; and |
| 21 | (b) pay apprentice wage rates, as applicable, in accordance with 39-6-108 for remediation completed by |
| 22 | an apprentice employed by a contractor or subcontractor." |
