8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Restrictions for collection of DNA from minor under 16 years of age
11	BY A PEACE OFFICER. A minor under 16 years of age may not have a DNA sample collected BY A PEACE OFFICER
12	unless:
13	(1) the minor was found under 41-5-1502 to have committed a sexual or violent offense;
14	(2) a parent or LEGAL guardian has provided written permission; or
15	(3) a court of competent jurisdiction has issued an order for the collection of a DNA sample.

17	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
18	integral part of Title 44, chapter 6, part 1, and the provisions of Title 44, chapter 6, part 1, apply to [section 1].
19	TITLE 46, CHAPTER 5, PART 4, AND THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 46, CHAPTER 5, PART 4, APPLY TO [SECTION 1].
