



AN ACT REVISING LAWS REGARDING PENALTIES FOR FALSELY REPORTING CRIMES; AND AMENDING SECTION 45-7-205, MCA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Section 45-7-205, MCA, is amended to read:

**"45-7-205. False reports to law enforcement authorities peace officers.** (1) A person commits an offense under this section if the person knowingly:

- (a) gives false information to any ~~law enforcement~~ peace officer with the purpose to implicate another;
- (b) reports to ~~law enforcement authorities~~ a peace officer an offense or other incident within ~~their~~ the officer's concern knowing that it did not occur; or
- (c) pretends to furnish ~~law enforcement authorities~~ a peace officer with information relating to an offense or incident when the person knows that the person has no information relating to the offense or incident.

(2) A person convicted under this section ~~shall~~ shall be ~~fined not to exceed \$500 or be imprisoned in the county jail for any term not to exceed 6 months, or both;~~

(a) if the crime falsely reported was a misdemeanor, sentenced to not more than 6 months in the county jail or fined not more than \$500, or both; or

(b) if the crime falsely reported was a felony, sentenced to not more than 4 years in the state prison or fined not more than \$10,000, or both."
