4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING DISCOUNTED LICENSES TO FIRST-TIME RESIDENT  
5 HUNTERS AND ANGLERS; AND PROVIDING A DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Licenses for first-time resident hunters and anglers.** (1) A resident, as  
10 defined in 87-2-102, who has never before obtained any fishing license pursuant to Title 87, chapter 2, may  
11 purchase a Class A fishing license for one-half the cost.12 (2) Except as provided in 87-2-810(8)(h), a resident, as defined in 87-2-102, who has never before  
13 obtained any hunting license pursuant to Title 87, chapter 2, may purchase the following for one-half the cost:

14 (a) a Class A-1 upland game bird license;

15 (b) a Class A-3 deer A tag;

16 (c) a Class A-5 elk tag;

17 (d) a Class AAA combination sports license that does not include a Class A-6 black bear tag.

19 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an  
20 integral part of Title 87, chapter 2, part 8, and the provisions of Title 87, chapter 2, part 8, apply to [section 1].

22 NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective March 1, 2020.
