11	"20-7-902. School district programs to identify and serve the gifted and talented child. (1) A
12	school district may shall may identify gifted and talented children and devise programs to serve them.
13	(2) In identifying gifted and talented children, the school district shall:
14	(a) consult with professionally qualified persons and the parents of children being evaluated;
15	(b) consider a child's demonstrated or potential gifts or talents; and
16	(c) use comprehensive and appropriate assessment methods including objective measures and
17	professional assessment measures. PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS THAT
18	ARE COMMENSURATE TO STUDENT NEEDS AND FOSTER A POSITIVE SELF-IMAGE.
19	(2) A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL may PROVIDE STRUCTURED SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE TO TEACHERS IN
20	IDENTIFYING AND MEETING THE DIVERSE STUDENT NEEDS OF GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS AND A FRAMEWORK FOR
