| 14 | person may not hunt or attempt to hunt furbearers, game animals, migratory game birds, nongame wildlife, |
| 15 | predatory animals, upland game birds, or wolves while hunting on private property without first obtaining |
| 16 | permission of the landowner, the lessee, or their agents. |
| 17 | (2) A person who violates this section shall, upon conviction for a first offense, be fined not less than |
