7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	Section 1. Section 61-9-420, MCA, is amended to read:
10	"61-9-420. Child safety restraint systems standards exemptions. (1) If a child under 6 years
11	of age and weighing less than 60 pounds is a passenger in a motor vehicle, that motor vehicle must be
12	equipped with one child safety restraint for each child in the vehicle and each child must be properly restrained.
13	Each motor vehicle passenger who is under 6 years of age and weighs less than 60 pounds must be
14	transported and properly restrained in a child safety restraint. The child safety restraint must be appropriate for
15	the height and weight of the child as indicated by manufacturer standards.
16	(2) The department shall by rule establish standards in compliance with 61-9-419 through 61-9-423
17	and applicable federal standards for approved types of child safety restraint systems.
18	(3) The department may by rule exempt from the requirements of subsection (1) a child who because
19	of a physical or medical condition or body size cannot be placed in a child safety restraint."
