| 10 | Section 1. Article V, section 4, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read: |
| 11 | "Section 4. Qualifications. A candidate for the legislature shall be a resident of the state for at leas |
| 12 | one year next 5 years preceding the general election. For six 6 months next-preceding the general election, he |
| 13 | the candidate shall be a resident of the county if it contains one or more districts or of the district if it contains all |
| 14 | or parts of more than one county." |

| 16 | NEW SECTION. Section 2. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal |
| 17 | to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote |
| 18 | of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage. |

| 20 | NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective upon approval by the electorate. |

| 22 | NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified |
| 23 | electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2022 by printing on the ballot the full title of |
| 24 | [this act] and the following: |
