11	"7-6-	-1501. Definitions. As used in this part, the following definitions apply:
12	(1)	"Board of directors" means the board of directors of the resort area district.
13	(2)	"Infrastructure" means tangible facilities and assets related to water, sewer, wastewater treatment,
14	storm water,	solid waste and utilities systems, fire protection, ambulance and law enforcement, roads, bridges,
15	and other tra	insportation needs.
16	(3)	"Luxuries" means any gift item, luxury item, or other item normally sold to the public or to transient
17	visitors or to	urists. The term does not include food purchased unprepared or unserved, medicine, medical
18	supplies and	services, appliances, hardware supplies and tools, or any necessities of life.
19	(4)	"Medical supplies" means items that are sold to be used for curative, prosthetic, or medical
20	maintenance	e purposes, whether or not prescribed by a physician.
21	(5)	"Medicine" means substances sold for curative or remedial properties, including both physician
22	prescribed a	nd over-the-counter medications.
23	(6)	"Qualified elector" means a person who is qualified to vote under 13-1-111 and is a resident of a
24	resort comm	unity, resort area, or proposed or established resort area district.
25	(7)	"Resort area" means an area that:
26	(a)	is an unincorporated area and is a defined contiguous geographic area;
27	(b)	has a population of less than 2,500 according to the most recent federal census;
28	(c)	derives the major portion of its economic well-being from businesses catering to the recreational

10	(c) derives the primary portion of its economic well-being related to current employment from	
11	businesses catering to the recreational and personal needs of persons traveling to or through the municipa	lity
12	or purposes not related to their income production; and	
13	(d) has been designated by the department of commerce as a resort community."
