<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> This bill has no fiscal impact to the state unless a new community college were approved by the legislature.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- 1. A general fund impact would only occur if a new community college were proposed and approved by the Legislature.
- 2. If a new community college was opened, the funding formula would utilize the average state support per resident student FTE of the community college appropriations less one-time-only appropriations and reversions (as a starting point) multiplied by projected resident student FTE provided by the trustees of a newly formed community college.
- 3. An additional appropriation would be required for audit.
