**Description of fiscal impact:** HB 285 allows an all-beverage licensee to operate a cigar bar if certain criteria are met and exempts these cigar bars from the Montana Clean Indoor Air Act.


### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### Assumptions:

1. Department of Revenue (DOR) costs associated with form development and implementation into the integrated tax system are minimal and will be absorbed by the department.

#### Technical Notes:

1. The bill does not specify if the Department of Revenue provides approval for the cigar bars. It will be difficult to ensure the criteria of New Section 1, (2)(b) through (2)(d) are met without an approval process.
2. It is unclear if cigar bars are allowed outdoors and, if so, what specific criteria must be met.
