Description of fiscal impact: HB 544 requires the Office of the Secretary of State to facilitate the name contest procedures in new Section 1. There is a fiscal impact to the office, related to legal work necessary to research each contest.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- 1. The Office of the Secretary of State estimates there will be 20 trademark registration contests a year with \$200 in revenue from each contest. The office will retain \$100 of this revenue and \$100 will be awarded to the prevailing party.
- 2. Each trademark registration contest will require an estimated 40 hours of legal work. The office will contract with Agency Legal Services (Department of Justice) to perform this work at a billing rate of \$121 per hour (\$96,800 per year). An inflationary factor of 1.5% has been added to this amount for fiscal years 2024 and 2025.
- 3. The office will need to hire an 0.50 FTE Customer Service Assistant 1 to perform research and to document the name contests at a market rate of \$22,536 for fiscal years 2022 and 2023 (\$45,072 for 1.00 FTE/2). An inflationary factor of 1.5% has been added to this amount for fiscal years 2024 and 2025.

- 4. The office will incur one-time costs in fiscal year 2022 for a new employee computer equipment (\$1,200) and office package (\$1,600).
- 5. An additional phone line will need to be added at a cost of \$332.52 per year. An inflationary factor of 1.5% has been added to this amount for fiscal years 2024 and 2025.
