Description of fiscal impact: HB 552 provides for a Racial Justice Act, which enables convicted persons to challenge the validity of their convictions through a habeas corpus petition. This will increase the caseload in Department of Justice and Office of Public Defender Prosecution Services Division and Appellate Services Division. The Judicial Branch will also an increase in caseload but is unable to estimate the fiscal impact.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

Department of Justice (DOJ)

Net Impact-General Fund Balance:

- 1. It is assumed that the increased workload from the passage of HB 552 will require the Department of Justice to hire additional staff as follows: 1.00 FTE Prosecution Attorney, 1.00 FTE Appellate Attorney and 0.50 FTE Paralegal.
- 2. The personal expenses for 2.5 FTE are estimated at \$306,501 in FY 2022 and FY 2023, \$311,099 in FY 2024 and \$315,766 in FY 2025 (a 1.5% inflation rate has been assumed)
- 3. Operating expenses are estimated at \$21,032 in FY 2022 with \$8,256 being one-time-only. Ongoing operational costs are estimated at \$12,776 in FY 2023, \$12,968 in FY 2024 and \$13,163 in FY 2025.

Office of Public Defender (OPD):

4. OPD assumes five new petitions in which defense may be appointed by the court under Section 7, part 3 (b). To accommodate work on these new petitions, OPD assumes the need for 1.00 FTE. The additional lawyer is calculated at a cost of \$95,903 for FY 2022 and FY 2023. There is an inflationary increase of 1.5% for FY 2024 and FY 2025. A one-time-only operating cost of \$2,800 for FY 2022 is also required.

Judicial Branch:

- 5. Section 4 introduces several new potential causes for a defendant to file a motion or file for writ of habeas corpus alleging a violation of these causes.
- 6. Adding more potential causes effectively adds more potential hearings which could increase judicial workload. However, the Judicial Branch is unable to estimate the impact on judicial workload or the fiscal impact. The cumulative impact of such legislation may eventually require additional judicial resources because the court dockets currently are full in many judicial districts throughout the state.
