
Description of fiscal impact: This bill has an unknown fiscal impact to the state general fund.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

Department of Justice

- At the end of the biennium, the balance in the state special revenue account may not exceed three times the amount of the budget appropriated to the Department of Justice. Any excess not awarded in judgement, cost, or fees must be transferred to the general fund no later than the first business day in January of the subsequent biennium.
- The overall impact to funds that are otherwise obligated to implement provisions of the settlement agreement is unknown. A positive impact to the general fund is cannot be determined.
