FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. HB 709 increases the fee for a marriage license when neither party is present at the solemnization.
2. The additional fee is captured by the county district court fund so there is no change in collections at the state level.
3. There was an average of 8,700 marriage licenses issued per year over the last four fiscal years.
4. The amount of increased county revenue cannot be reliably estimated.
