Assumptions:

Department of Livestock

1. The proposed legislation authorizes the Livestock Loss Board (LLB) to pay a multiplier for livestock losses due to wolves or grizzly bears based on regional rates established by the board.
2. Currently \$300,000 is appropriated annually for livestock loss payments and payments will be made withing existing appropriations.
3. There will be no new FTE required for the administration of these funds.
