## **Assumptions:**

- 1. This legislation extends HB 15 from the 2019 session by two years.
- 2. The proposed legislation does not require additional work by Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to administer the county motor vehicle recycling and disposal program grants.
- 3. Counties are left to their discretion whether to take responsibility for non-motorized vehicles at their motor vehicle graveyards using existing funds.
- 4. No additional grant monies will be requested by counties accepting non-motorized vehicles at their motor vehicle graveyards.
