Technical Concerns:

1. Lines 11-13 state that if the rule fails to note the date on which and the manner in which written contact was made or attempted to be made for each person required under this subsection, the rule adoption is ineffective. This may have an unintended consequence. For example: if an agency had to contact 10 people and the date was inadvertently left off one notice, would the emergency rule by invalidated? This ambiguity appears to require further clarification.
