Description of fiscal impact: This proposed legislation would amend 45-8-213, MCA, by adding a proposed new subsection (2)(a)(v) to create a new exception to a potential violation of 45-8- 213(1)(c), MCA.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

1. The Department of Corrections (DOC) has only 2 offenders, currently incarcerated, that might be affected by the change in bill language.
2. It is not clear what impact this might have on DOC. The new exceptions may decrease the number of convictions of this criminal provision.
3. No significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
