Description of fiscal impact: HB 517 reduces the penalty for possession of marijuana for under the age of 21 and will have a negative fiscal impact due to reduced fine revenue being collected.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

Department of Justice

- 1. The Montana Highway Patrol (MHP) issued an average of 243 citations under 45-5-624, MCA, between 2016 and 2020.
- 2. MHP assumes that 30% of the citations were marijuana related.
- 3. MHP assumes a decrease in revenue of \$3,650 due to the current fee of \$100 not being received. (243 citations $\times 30\% = 73$ marijuana citations) (73 x \$100 fine= \$7,300) (\$7,300 / 2= \$3,650)
- 4. Half of the fines are deposited into the state general fund and half go to the county in which the citation was written.
