**Net Impact-General Fund Balance:** 

- 1. Section 1 of the bill creates the Montana Military Strategic and Economic Impact Task Force and administratively attaches it to the Department of Commerce.
- 2. The task force will be comprised of ten members serving staggered terms and all will be entitled to reimbursement for expenses as provided in 2-18-501 through 2-18-503, MCA.
- 3. The effective date of the bill is July 1, 2021.
- 4. Section 1(4) calls for the task force to examine potential base realignment and closure actions, study the economic and strategic impact of those proposed actions, develop a strategic plan to position the state, as well as the preparation of various reports and presentations.

- 5. Section 1(6) requires the task force to formulate a budget and submit a copy of that budget to the State Administration and Veterans' Affairs interim committee by December 31, 2021. It is assumed that the task force will require extensive support from department staff or a consultant to assist in the completion of these tasks.
- 6. Section 2 of the bill appropriates from the general fund, \$250,000 for the biennium ending June 30, 2023 to conduct the economic impact study and other tasks outlined in Section 1(4), and \$163,000 for each year of the biennium ending June 30, 2023 to establish and administer the task force.
- 7. For the purposes of this fiscal note the \$250,000 appropriated for the tasks outlined in Section 1(4) will be evenly distributed in both years of the biennium at \$125,000 (\$250,000 / 2).
- 8. The bill does not state the frequency of task force meeting, however for the purposes of this fiscal note it is assumed that the task force will meet once a month beginning in July of 2021.
- 9. To provide administrative support to the task force in the items outlined above it is assumed that it will require 1.00 FTE.
- 10. Since this taskforce has no termination date it is assumed that the expenses and funding will carry forward into subsequent biennia at a similar rate.
- 11. A 1.5% annual inflation rate is applied for the 2025 biennium.
