Description of fiscal impact: This bill has no fiscal impact to the state.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- 1. HB 559 amends the provision of statute requiring a prosecutor to provide notice of a request and of a filing of a declaratory judgement action to a person with a privacy interest in the information requested and anyone else who could be affected by its release.
- 2. The bill would also require the court to conduct an in camera review of the CCJI within 60 days after filing the declaratory judgment.
- 3. These statutory amendments cause no fiscal impact to the state.
