Description of fiscal impact: HB 700 revises laws related to forestry and agriculture. A person claiming a share of abandoned interest related to abandoned machinery, construction equipment, or farm equipment must submit a \$25 fee to the Department of Revenue. It is anticipated a minimal number of claims will be made each year, and for fiscal note purposes, the impact of HB 700 is assumed to be zero.

Technical Notes:

- HB 700 does not specify where the fee paid to the Department of Revenue would be deposited or how the fee revenue would be used. Further clarification may be needed.
