FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- SB 33 will require a 30-day notification to a person participating in a Medicaid home and community-based services waiver before terminating the person's participation in the waiver. The current notification requirement is 10 days. Procedurally, moving to a 30-day notification will only require the Department of Public Health and Human Services to provide the same notice earlier. SB 33 will not require any additional resources.
