Description of fiscal impact: SB 125 has no fiscal impact to the state.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. This legislation extends HB 15 from the 2019 session by two years.
2. The proposed legislation does not require additional work by Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to administer the county motor vehicle recycling and disposal program grants.
3. Counties are left to their discretion whether to take responsibility for non-motorized vehicles at their motor vehicle graveyards using existing funds.
4. No additional grant monies will be requested by counties accepting non-motorized vehicles at their motor vehicle graveyards.

Technical Notes:

1. The term non-motorized vehicle is not defined in Montana Code Annotated.
