<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> This bill has no fiscal impact to the state.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- 1. SB 208 adds the option for a person who is not successful in a limited license drawing to donate their refunded amount to the Hunters Against Hunger account or the Habitat Montana account.
- 2. The existing law that this bill amends allows a person to donate their refunded amount to the Block Management program, but it is not effective until March 1, 2022. Therefore, the Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks does not have historical data regarding how many people would utilize the option to donate their refund.
- 3. The department assumes no change to the number of persons willing to donate their refunded amount. However, the department assumes this would change the distribution of those donated funds.
