FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- 1. SB 378 conflicts with 23-5-503(4)(c) MCA, which prohibits a licensed gambling operator from using a sports pool game in any manner to establish odds or handicaps or allow betting or booking.
- 2. The department may charge a nominal fee to review variations in the authorized sports pools, but the fiscal impact is anticipated to be minimal.
