Short Title: Revise laws related to facial recognition technology

Generally, why do you disagree with the fiscal note?

The fiscal note includes tasks that would be required by the DMV, Dept. of Labor and corrections to act.

With the proposed amendment that will be offered on the floor, the DMV, Dept. of Labor and Dept. of Corrections will be excluded from participating under this bill.

I anticipate there will still be a fiscal note for the DOJ, but due to the exemptions of the above listed departments the fiscal note will need to be updated and lessened if it passes the House.

Specifically, what in the fiscal note do you feel is flawed?

I think it will just need to be updated after an amendment attaches excluding many of the assumptions/tasks listed in the fiscal note.

What is your estimate of the fiscal impact?

Slightly less than what is currently listed (\$20,000) due to the amendment that will exempt multiple departments from participating under this bill.
