| 9 | Section 1. Section 18-2-416, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 10 | "18-2-416. Wages paid to registered apprentices. (1) (a) Only an apprentice whose indenture |
| 11 | agreement is registered with the department under Title 39, chapter 6, or recognized by the department as |
| 12 | being registered with an appropriate registration agency of another state or the federal government may be paid |
| 13 | as provided in subsection (2) when working on a public works contract. |
| 14 | (b) An apprentice whose indenture agreement is not registered with or recognized by the department |
| 15 | must be paid the full amount of the standard prevailing rate of wages, including any applicable travel |
| 16 | allowances. |
| 17 | (c) Apprenticeship wages start-An APPRENTICESHIP'S RATE OF WAGES STARTS at the date of registration |
| 18 | with the sponsor. |
| 19 | (2) A recognized, registered apprentice must be paid the percentage of the standard prevailing rate of |
| 20 | wages provided for in the apprenticeship standards applicable to that apprentice. The percentage amount |
| 21 | applies to wage rates only and not to fringe benefits. The full amount of any applicable fringe benefits must be |
| 22 | paid to the apprentice while the apprentice is working on the public works contract." |
