10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	SECTION 1. SECTION 37-33-406, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
13	"37-33-406. (Temporary) Massage therapy businesses requirements. (1) A massage therapy
14	business shall conspicuously display on the premises the license of each massage therapist working at the
15	business or, for a mobile practice, make the license readily available.
16	(2) (a) The department or a local designee, a local government official having jurisdiction, or a local
17	law enforcement officer may enter a massage therapy business at any time during business hours to determine
18	compliance with subsection (1).
19	(b) The action taken under subsection (2)(a) may not interrupt a treatment session that is in progress,
20	except that a treatment session lasting 2 hours or more may be interrupted. (Terminates June 30, 2023sec. 6,
21	Ch. 419, L. 2019.) "
