| 9  | Section 1. Section 61-9-420, MCA, is amended to read:   |
| 10 | "61-9-420. Child safety restraint systems standards exemptions. (1) If a child under 6 years                        |
| 11 | of age and weighing less than 60 pounds is a passenger in a motor vehicle, that motor vehicle must be               |
| 12 | equipped with one child safety restraint for each child in the vehicle and each child must be properly restrained.  |
| 13 | Each motor vehicle passenger who is under 6 years of age and weighs less than 60 pounds must be                     |
| 14 | transported and properly restrained in a child safety restraint. The child safety restraint must be appropriate for |
| 15 | the height and weight of the child as indicated by manufacturer standards.  |
| 16 | (2) The department shall by rule establish standards in compliance with 61-9-419 through 61-9-423                   |
| 17 | and applicable federal standards for approved types of child safety restraint systems.                              |
| 18 | (3) The department may by rule exempt from the requirements of subsection (1) a child who because                   |
| 19 | of a physical or medical condition or body size cannot be placed in a child safety restraint."                      |
