10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 7-32-232, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"7-32-232. Role of auxiliary officers. (1) Auxiliary officers:
14	(a) are subordinate to full-time law enforcement officers; and
15	(b) may not serve unless supervised by a full-time law enforcement officer.
16	(2) No auxiliary officer may carry a weapon while on assigned duty. An auxiliary officer may carry a
17	weapon while on an official SEARCH AND RESCUE mission with prior approval from the sheriff."
