16	(4) is licensed or certified as a psychologist in another jurisdiction that has a disciplinary pro-	ocess as

18	(5) has actively practiced psychology under a license as described in subsection (4) or main	ntained
19	certification OR CERTIFICATION as described in subsection (4) for 5 of the 7 years immediately preceding

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Licensure of postdoctoral supervisees. (1) (a) Except as pr	ovided in
27	subsection (1)(b), if a person submits evidence that the person is engaged in a postdoctoral supervision	
28	program as part of a plan approved by the board and meets the qualifications of 37-17-302, the boar	d shall

- 2 (b) A person licensed under this subsection (1) is not required to pass the prescribed exam and have 3 1 year of postdoctoral supervised experience as provided in 37-17-302(4).
  - (2) The person may only practice as described in the approved postdoctoral supervision plan.
- 5 (3) The license provided for in this section expires at the conclusion of the approved postdoctoral supervision program, unless the person meets all of the qualifications in 37-17-302.
