4	(c) In addition to the salary provided for in subsections (1) and (2)(b), the county sheriff may receive
5	any additional salary as determined by the board of county commissioners. The additional salary provided in
6	this subsection (2)(c) must be included as salary for the purposes of computing the compensation for
7	undersheriffs and deputy sheriffs as provided in 7-4-2508.
8	(c)(d) The county sheriff must receive a longevity payment amounting to 1% of the salary determined
9	under subsection (1) subsections (1) and (2)(b) for each year of service with the sheriff's office, but years of
10	service during any year in which the salary was set at the level of the salary of the prior fiscal year may not be
11	included in any calculation of longevity increases. The payment, nonpayment, increase, lack of increase, or
12	decrease of the discretionary salary under subsection (2)(c) has no impact on the longevity payment. The
13	additional salary amount provided for in this subsection may not be included in the salary for purposes of
14	computing the compensation for undersheriffs and deputy sheriffs as provided in 7-4-2508.
15	(d)(e) If the clerk and recorder is also the county election administrator, the clerk and recorder may
16	receive, in addition to the base salary provided in subsection (1)(a), up to \$2,000 a year. The additional salary
17	provided for in this subsection (2)(d) (2)(e) may not be included as salary for the purposes of computing the
18	compensation of any other county officers or employees.
19	(e)(f) The county treasurer, clerk of district court, and justice of the peace may each receive, in
20	addition to the base salary provided in subsection (1)(a), up to \$2,000 a year. The additional salary provided for
21	in this subsection (2)(e) (2)(f) may not be included as salary for the purposes of computing the compensation of
22	any other county officers or employees.
23	(f)(g) The county coroner may be a part-time position, and the salary may be set accordingly.
24	(g)(h) The justice of the peace for a justice's court of record may receive, in addition to the base
25	salary provided in subsection (1)(a), compensation up to an amount allowed by 3-10-207.
26	(3) (a) Subject to subsection (3)(b), the salary for the county attorney must be set as provided in
27	subsection (4).
28	(b) If the uniform base salary set for county officials pursuant to subsection (1) is increased, then the



county attorney is entitled to at least the same increase unless the increase would cause the county attorney's
 salary to exceed the salary of a district court judge.

3 (c) (i) After completing 4 years of service as deputy county attorney, each deputy county attorney is 4 entitled to an increase in salary of \$1,000 on the anniversary date of employment as deputy county attorney. 5 After completing 5 years of service as deputy county attorney, each deputy county attorney is entitled to an 6 additional increase in salary of \$1,500 on the anniversary date of employment. After completing 6 years of 7 service as deputy county attorney and for each year of additional service up to completion of the 11th year of 8 service, each deputy county attorney is entitled to an additional annual longevity salary increase of \$500 or a 9 greater amount based on the schedule developed and recommended by the county compensation board as 10 provided in subsection (4). Any additional annual longevity salary increase provided for in this section after the 11 11th year of service may not exceed the amount provided in the schedule developed and recommended by the 12 county compensation board.

(ii) The years of service accumulated after the 11th year of service as a deputy county attorney prior to
 July 1, 2015, may not be included in the calculation of the longevity increases by the county compensation
 board under this section.

(iii) The years of service as a deputy county attorney accumulated prior to July 1, 1985, must be
 included in the calculation of the longevity increase.

18 (4) (a) There is a county compensation board consisting of:

19 (i) the county commissioners;

20 (ii) three of the county officials described in subsection (1) appointed by the board of county

21 commissioners;

22 (iii) the county attorney;

23 (iv) two to four resident taxpayers appointed initially by the board of county commissioners to

staggered terms of 3 years, with the initial appointments of one or two taxpayer members for a 2-year term and

25 one or two taxpayer members for a 3-year term; and

26 (v) (A) subject to subsection (4)(a)(v)(B), one resident taxpayer appointed by each of the three

27 county officials described in subsection (4)(a)(ii).

28 (B) The appointments in subjection (4)(a)(v)(A) are not mandatory.

2	(a) <u>"compensation"</u> "Compensation" means the base rate of pay and does not mean longevity
3	payments or payments for hours worked overtime.
4	(b) "Salary of that sheriff" means the total salary provided for in 7-4-2503(1), (2)(b), and (2)(c)."
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6	Section 3. Section 7-4-2510, MCA, is amended to read:
7	"7-4-2510. Sheriff's office longevity payments. Beginning on the date of the deputy sheriff's or
8	undersheriff's first anniversary of employment with the office and adjusted annually, a deputy sheriff or
9	undersheriff is entitled to receive a longevity payment amounting to 1% of the minimum base annual salary for
10	each year of service with the office, but years of service during any year in which the salary was set at the
11	same level as the salary of the prior fiscal year may not be included in any calculation of longevity increases.
12	This payment must be made in equal monthly installments. The payment, nonpayment, increase, lack of
13	increase, or decrease of the discretionary salary under 7-4-2503(2)(c) has no impact on the longevity payment."
