7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Stop signs.** A bicyclist may treat a stop sign as a yield sign by slowing to  
10 a reasonable speed, yielding the right-of-way to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching the intersection,  
11 and then cautiously making a turn or proceeding through the intersection.

13 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an  
14 integral part of Title 61, chapter 8, part 6, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter 8, part 6, apply to [section 1].
