16	of up to \$500 to current members of the Montana national guard in the pay grades of E-1 to O-5 or any former		
17	member of the Montana national guard honorably discharged veteran for each new or prior service recruit that		
18	a service member refers to the Montana national guard.		
19	(3)	The following personnel are ineligible for enlistment incentive program payments:
