10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Containment required for inspection. (1) Livestock must be contained
13	by the owner in a space appropriate for a required regulatory action under 81-2-102.
14	(2) The owner shall remain present with the livestock and assist the department as necessary for
15	the efficient completion of regulatory action under 81-2-102.
16	(3) (a) An owner who violates the provisions of subsection (1) or (2) shall pay for the wages and
17	expenses of each department employee present for the required regulatory action under 81-2-102, including:
18	(i) the department employee's hourly rate of pay; and
19	(ii) travel, meals, and lodging expenses.
20	(b) Subsection (3)(a) does not preclude the department from seeking remedies for violation of
21	subsection (1) or (2) as provided in 81-2-109 or 81-2-113.
22	(4) The department may provide <u>a</u> chute and alley as needed to complete inspection or testing.
23	
24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
25	integral part of Title 81, chapter 2, part 1, and the provisions of Title 81, chapter 2, part 1, apply to [section 1].
