11	Section 1. Section 90-7-225, MCA, is amended to read:		
12	"90-7-225. Procedure prior to financing qualified small bond issue projects. (1) In addition to		
13	meeting the other requirements contained in this chapter or in state or federal law, the requirements of		
14	subsections (2) through (4) must be met before financing is provided for a project described in 90-7-104(1)(I).		
15	(2) The authority shall find that the financing is in the public interest. In order to determine whether		
16	or not the financing is in the public interest, a public hearing must be conducted in the following manner:		
17	(a) the The city or county in which the project will be located must be notified of project information,		
18	including a project description, the name of the borrower, and the approximate par value of the bonds., and the		
19	The city and county shall, within 44 30 days after receipt of the notice, notify the board if it elects to conduct the		
20	hearing, even if the local government is not the issuer of the bonds.; or		
21	(b) if-If a request for a local hearing is not received by the authority within-14 30 days after the		
22	notification in subsection (2)(a), the authority may hold the hearing at a time and place it determines.		
23	(3) Notice of the <u>authority's</u> hearing must be published at least <del>once a week for 2 weeks 7 calendar</del>		
24	days prior to the date set for the hearing by publication on a governmental unit website or in a newspaper of		
25	general circulation in the city or county where the hearing will be held and the project will be located. The notice		
26	must include the time and place of the hearing, a general description of the nature and location of the project,		
27	the name of the lessee, borrower, or user of the project and the maximum principal amount of the financing to		
28	be provided by the authority.		



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1	(4)	If the hearing required by subsection (2) is conducted by a local government, the governing	
2	body of the local government shall notify the authority of its determination of whether the financing is in the		
3	public interest within 14 days after the completion of the public hearing."

9	(2)	The authority shall find that the financing is in the public interest. In order to determine whether	
10	or not the fina	ncing is in the public interest, a public hearing must be conducted in the following manner:	
11	(a)	the city or county in which the project will be located must be notified, and the city and county	
12	shall, within 14 days after receipt of the notice, notify the board if it elects to conduct the hearing; or		
13	(b)	if a request for a local hearing is not received by the authority within 14 days after the	
14	notification in	subsection (2)(a), the authority may hold the hearing at a time and place it determines.	
15	(3)	Notice of the hearing must be published at least once a week for 2 weeks 7 calendar days prio

21	(4)	If the hearing required by subsection (2) is conducted by a local government, the governing	
22	body of the loc	cal government shall notify the authority of its determination of whether the financing is in the	
23	public interest	within 14 days after the completion of the public hearing."
