- Section 3. Section 5-5-211, MCA, is amended to read:
- "5-5-211. Appointment and composition of interim committees. (1) Senate interim committee
 members must be appointed by the committee on committees.
- 21 (2) House interim committee members must be appointed by the speaker of the house.
- 22 (3) Appointments to interim committees must be made by the time of adjournment of the legislative 23 session.
 - (4) A legislator may not serve on more than two interim committees unless no other legislator is available or is willing to serve.
- 26 (5) (a) Subject to 5-5-234 and subsection (5)(b) of this section, the composition of each interim committee must be as follows:



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
