12	in subsection (2), the following elections for a special purpose district must be held on the same day as the
13	regular school election day established in 20-20-105(1), which is the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May
14	(a) an election to create, alter the boundaries of, continue, or dissolve a special purpose district;
15	and
16	(b) an election to fill a special purpose district office.
17	(2) (a) A special purpose district election that includes a question affecting district funding, such as
18	fee assessments, bonds, or the sale or lease of property, may be held on the day specified in subsection (1) or
19	scheduled as a special election.
20	(b) A conservation district election must be held on a primary or general election day.
21	(c) If the special purpose district will be administered by a city or town city, town, or consolidated
22	city-county, the-city or town city, town, or consolidated city-county may schedule an election to create, dissolve,
23	or continue a special purpose district on the same day as the general election day.
24	(3) If specifically authorized by law, a special purpose district election may be held at the district's
25	annual meeting.
26	(4) A special purpose district election may not be held earlier than 85 days after the date of the
