4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REMOVING THE LIMIT ON PRIZES FOR INDIVIDUAL LIVE CARD
5 GAMES; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 23-5-312 AND 23-5-710, MCA."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 **Section 1.** Section 23-5-312, MCA, is amended to read:

10 **"23-5-312. ~~Prizes not to exceed \$800~~ Payment of prizes -- exception -- taxes on certain**

11 **winnings.** ~~(1)~~ ~~(1) A prize for an individual live card game may not exceed the value of \$800. Games may not be~~
12 ~~combined in any manner so as to increase the value of the ultimate prize awarded. There is no value limit on~~
13 ~~prizes for individual live card games. Except during a tournament conducted under 23-5-317, all prizes must be~~
14 ~~awarded immediately upon on completion of each hand.~~

15 ~~(2) If a licensed operator conducts a promotional game of chance involving a live card game, the prize~~
16 ~~limit provided for in subsection (1) applies to prizes awarded as a result of the promotional game of chance.~~

17 **(2) For games in which a prize for an individual live card game exceeds the value of \$800, the**
18 **licensed live card game operator shall pay to the department a tax of 15% of the winnings. The department may**
19 **use the collected taxes to support gambling disorder treatment, including but not limited to public outreach and**
20 **education.**

22 **Section 2.** Section 23-5-710, MCA, is amended to read:

23 **"23-5-710. Requirements for conducting casino nights.** A nonprofit organization that has obtained
24 a permit under 23-5-706 shall conduct a casino night in compliance with the following conditions:

25 (1) (a) Except as provided in subsection (1)(b), a casino night may not last more than 12
26 consecutive hours.

27 (b) A casino night may be split into two separate, 6-consecutive hour sessions that may not be

1 held on the same day but must be held in the same calendar year.

2 (2) The casino night must be managed and operated only by members of the nonprofit
3 organization that was issued the permit under 23-5-706. The members may not be compensated for their
4 services.

5 (3) Only merchandise or cash may be awarded as prizes.

6 (4) Proceeds derived from the casino night, after payment of reasonable administrative expenses,
7 may be used only for a civic, charitable, or educational purpose, and administrative expenses may not exceed
8 50% of the proceeds.

9 (5) If cash prizes are awarded, the prizes for bingo and keno may not exceed the prize limits
10 established in 23-5-412. Live card games must be limited to those authorized in 23-5-311, and the prizes may
11 not exceed the prize amount established in are subject to 23-5-312.

12 (6) A casino night may not include a card game tournament provided for in 23-5-317."
