9	WHEF	REAS, ARM 42.11.402 and 42.13.201 specifically prohibit the approval of gelatin cup alcoholic			
10	products for use in Montana and the amendment to section 16-1-303, MCA, seeks to have the department				
11	remove that prohibition.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15	Section 1. Section 16-1-303, MCA, is amended to read:				
16	"16-1-	303. Department rules. (1) The department and the department of justice may make rules not			
17	inconsistent with this code necessary to efficiently administer this code.				
18	(2)	Rules made by the department may include but are not limited to the following:			
19	(a)	regulating the contractual operation of agency liquor stores and warehouses in which liquor is			
20	kept or sold and prescribing the books and records to be kept;				
21	(b)	prescribing the duties of department employees and regulating their conduct while in the			
22	discharge of their duties;				
23	(c)	governing the purchase of liquor and the furnishing of liquor to agency liquor stores;			
24	(d)	determining the classes, varieties, and brands of liquor to be available for distribution from the			
25	state liquor warehouse, however, the department may not prohibit gelatin cup alcoholic beverage products that				
26	are liquid at room temperature from distribution from the state liquor warehouse;				
27	(e)	prescribing the minimum hours during which agency liquor stores must be open for the sale of			
28	alcoholic beverages;
