18	board rule. Some of the required hours must be in direct client contact.
19	(2) After completing the required supervised work experience as a social worker licensure
20	candidate or by meeting the requirements of subsection (5), the applicant shall:
21	(a) <u>subject to subsection (6)(b)(5)</u> , satisfactorily complete an examination prescribed by the board
