15	(2)	The department may issue special licenses to hunt wild buffalo or bison designated as a	
16	species in need of disease control when authorized by the department of livestock.		
17	(3)	The department shall adopt rules in cooperation with the department of livestock. The rules	
18	must provide for:		
19	(a)	license drawing procedures;	
20	(b)	application fees consistent with 87-2-113;	
21	(c)	notification of license recipients as to when and where they may hunt;	
22	(d)	fair chase hunting of wild buffalo or bison, including requirements that hunting be conducted on
