A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING LAWS PERTAINING TO VIDEO-GAMBLING MACHINE PRIZES; INCREASING THE LIMIT ON PRIZES FOR AN INDIVIDUAL LIVE CARD GAME FROM \$800 TO \$1,999; INCREASING THE LIMIT ON VIDEO GAMBLING MACHINE GAME LIMITS FROM $\$ 2$ TO \$3; INCREASING THE LIMIT ON AWARDING FREE GAMES OR CREDITS FROM $\$ 800$ TO $\$ 1,199$; REVISING THE CREDIT RATIO FOR CERTAIN VIDEO GAMBLING MACHINE GAMES; AMENDING SECTIONS 23-5312, $23-5-607_{2}$ AND 23-5-608, MCA; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES AND AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-5-312, MCA, is amended to read:
"23-5-312. Prizes not to exceed $\$ 800 \$ 1,999$. (1) A prize for an individual live card game may not exceed the value of $\$ 800 \$ 1,999$. Games may not be combined in any manner so as to increase the value of the ultimate prize awarded. Except during a tournament conducted under 23-5-317, all prizes must be awarded immediately upon completion of each hand.
(2) If a licensed operator conducts a promotional game of chance involving a live card game, the prize limit provided for in subsection (1) applies to prizes awarded as a result of the promotional game of chance."

Section 2. Section 23-5-607, MCA, is amended to read:
"23-5-607. Expected payback -- verification. (1) The department shall prescribe the expected payback value of credit awarded to be at least $80 \%$ of the value of credit played for each bingo, poker, keno, and video line game in a video gambling machine. The credit ratio may not be greater than:
(a) 92\% for each video line game;
(b) $96.5 \%$ for each bingo and keno game; and
